The **Orchestra Study** is a **Phase 2a**, randomized, double-blind, placebo-controlled study to investigate the efficacy, safety, tolerability, and pharmacokinetics of oral **UCB0599** in patients with **early-stage Parkinson's disease** to evaluate whether UCB0599 can slow the progression of Parkinson's Disease.

Participants eligible for this study should be 40–75 years of age, diagnosed with Parkinson's disease within the past 2 years and in early stages of Parkinson's disease (modified Hoehn and Yahr Stage ≤ 2).
